Venues at Risk Survey

One of the key pillars of the Motorsport UK Vision 2030 Strategy is venues and events. As part of this, we are looking to understand which current venues are at risk of being lost. Clubs often report that venue loss is their number one concern.

Motorsport venues are often vulnerable to:

- Development pressure
- Noise complaints
- Financial viability
- Land use changes

A register of at risk venues allows us to:

- Identify threats early rather than reacting when it's too late
- Prioritise interventions
- Develop tools to help Clubs

4 Years of StreetCar

In 2022 Motorsport UK created the [StreetCar](#) initiative, designed to help raise the profile of grassroots motorsport and get more people enjoying motorsport, more often. Showcasing the disciplines that can be accessed with a free RS Clubman licence, any road registered car and no additional PPE or safety equipment, StreetCar is the most accessible way of getting into motorsport.

Over the past 4 years, StreetCar has directed hundreds of curious would-be competitors to motor Clubs around the UK to start their motorsport journey. If your Club runs the following types of events, you can become a StreetCar Club and get sent local enquiries:

- Autotest, AutoSOLO and Production Car Autotest
- Trials and untimed Cross Country events
- Rally including Touring Assemblies, Treasure Hunts, Navigational Scatter, Navigational Rally, Road and Historic Rally, 12 Car Rally and Targa Rally
