

Young Volunteer of the Year

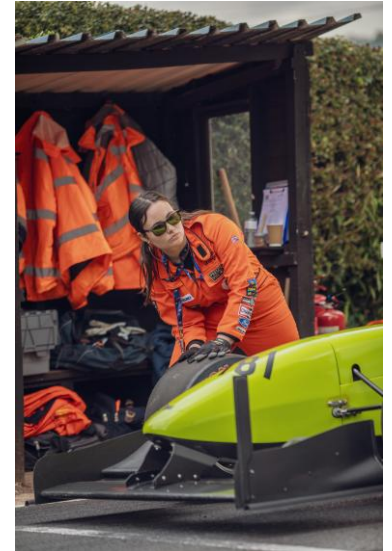
New for 2026, the Young Volunteer of the Year award recognises the hard work, dedication, and leadership demonstrated by volunteers in the sport **under the age of 35**.

This new award provides a fantastic opportunity to recognise emerging talent and say thank you to those helping to drive our sport forward.

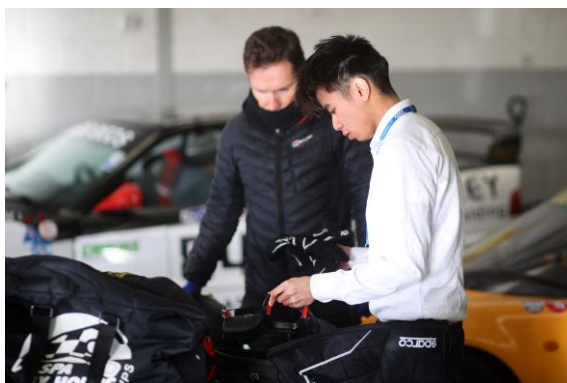


When filling out the Volunteer of the Year form you should consider elements such as:

- Showing outstanding dedication
- Leadership and team skills
- Personal growth through challenges faced
- Impacting the wider community and inspiring others

Top Tips:

- We would recommend using the “PEE” method; make your Point, share your Evidence and Explain what you are sharing.
- Please pay special attention to the word limit for each question. This will help you shape your answers as one-line responses do not tend to be highly marked.



Nominations are to be submitted via the [online nomination form](#), and only information submitted on this form can be considered by the awards panel. Once you have started the online form, you can save your progress and complete it in stages until you are ready to submit your nomination.

Important Information:

- The nominations received throughout the year will be contacted directly by the end of December.
- Please note that the nominations are reviewed by an external panel against the criteria we provide, so by paying special attention to this document and the attributes mentioned, you can score highly when filling out the online form.
- Please only submit one nomination; there's no need to submit multiple nominations for the same nominee.
- There is no limit to the number of endorsements an Association can make for the Motorsport UK Volunteer of the Year Award and no limit to the number of nominations a Club, Group or Association can make for this award.
- No Motorsport UK employee or contractor can nominate for the awards.
