### Proposed Regulation

## Section Q – Circuit Racing

### Championships

6.1. Please refer to Section W – Championships.

6.2. Series. A series of individual Events organised to a common set of Sporting and/or Technical Regulations with no accumulative winner.

6.2.1. A Series may not be titled to suggest an overall Award. It must not have any reference to Cup, Trophy or any other similar title.

6.2.2. A Series Calendar can have no more than 6 Events and may not include any non-UK Events.

6.3. All Series must be registered with Motorsport UK. Application must be made by using ~~on~~ the prescribed form which will include: (a) title (b) vehicle and (c) minimum licence status, and submitted to the Head of Race together with the Series Regulations written to the prescribed format.

6.3.1. A Registration Fee will be levied by the ASN. The Registration will be accepted by the issue of a Series Permit Registration document.

6.3.4. It is the Organising Permit holder's responsibility to ensure that any Event possesses either a Championship Permit or a Series Permit Registration document, as appropriate.

## National Competition Rules – Chapter 12, Race

### Appendix 2, Championships and Series

#### Series

3. A series of individual Events organised by a recognised Club to a common set of Sporting and/or Technical Regulations with no accumulative winner must be registered with the ASN. Applications must be made using ~~on~~ the prescribed form and submitted to the Head of Race together with the Series Regulations written to the prescribed format. which must include:

a. title

b. Vehicle(s) and

c. minimum licence status.

4. A Series may not be titled to suggest an overall Award. It must not have any reference to Cup, Trophy or any other similar title.
5. A Series Calendar can have no more than 6 Events and may not include any non-UK Events.
64. A Registration Fee will be levied by the ASN as published from time to time (Chapter 1 App.2).
75. Registration will be accepted by the issue of a Series Permit Registration document.

**Date of Implementation: 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025**

**Reason:** It has become apparent that a number of Series have been presenting end of season awards in contravention of existing regulations. Further, it is not always clear to Competitors what the difference is between a Championship and a Series and it was considered that clear regulation was required. Motorsport UK will mandate specific wording at the head of any set of Series Regulations which will make this clear.

To mark this clear distinction between a Championships and a Series there can be no reference to Cup, Trophy or any similar title that would give any perception of an overall award. It is also proposed that any Series be restricted to a maximum of 6 Events.

In addition within the framework of the FIA International Sporting Code there is provision for a national Event to visit a Venue outside the nation's border, this however is reserved for National Championships. A Series cannot be provided the ASN authority for any visit outside its territory.
