

Sport:80 – Screening Request

What is a Screening Request?

A screening request is another term for suitability or vetting check. Via Sport:80, this means a DBS check for England, Wales, Channel Islands and Isle Of Man. You can also submit an Access NI suitability check via Sport:80.

PVG checks for Scotland are handled externally and will be inputted into the system manually.

Who needs to submit a Screening Request?

If you do not hold a current DBS certificate or a PVG check, you will need to complete this before renewing your licence.

Screening Requests are a condition of licencing for the following roles:

- Club Safeguarding Officer (Enhanced with Children's Barred List)
- Medical / Rescue (Enhanced with Children and Adult's Barred List)
- Volunteer Officials – Regulated Activity (Enhanced with Children's Barred List)
- Coaches – Regulated Activity (Enhanced with Children's Barred List)
- Team Managers (Enhanced with Children's Barred List)
- Instructor / Trainer – U18's (Enhanced with Children's Barred List)

Team Manager - Children	Supervisor – Child
Trainer – U18's	Volunteer Official – Regulated Activity
Motorsport Coach 1 (Coach or Mechanic)	Volunteer Official – Non-Regulated Activity



Adding a current DBS/PVG check

DBS checks for England, Wales, Northern Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man are valid for 3 years from the date of issue. For Scotland, PVG checks do not expire. Once they are in place, you do not need to renew it.

If you have a current valid DBS/PVG check in place, you can upload this onto Sport:80, submitting both:

- Date of Issue
- Certificate Number
