7. Practice and Starts

7.4 Vehicles will be started from a Standing Start and the Finish line must be clearly indicated. **A Vehicle will be considered to have started once it has crossed the start line, under its own power following a successful start. The vehicle must leave the pre-grid area and arrive at its designated start position under its own power.**

- a. **Standing start:** A standing start occurs when the Vehicles are stationary on their appropriate grid positions with engines running when the starting Signal is given. Timing shall commence when the starting Signal is given. The starting line is the line in relation to which the position of each Vehicle is fixed prior to the start.
- b. Electronic beams or similar devices may be used in conjunction with starting lights to detect false starts. These will be monitored by a Judge of Fact.
